We look forward to seeing you in Vienna!

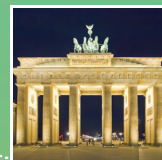

CYCLE

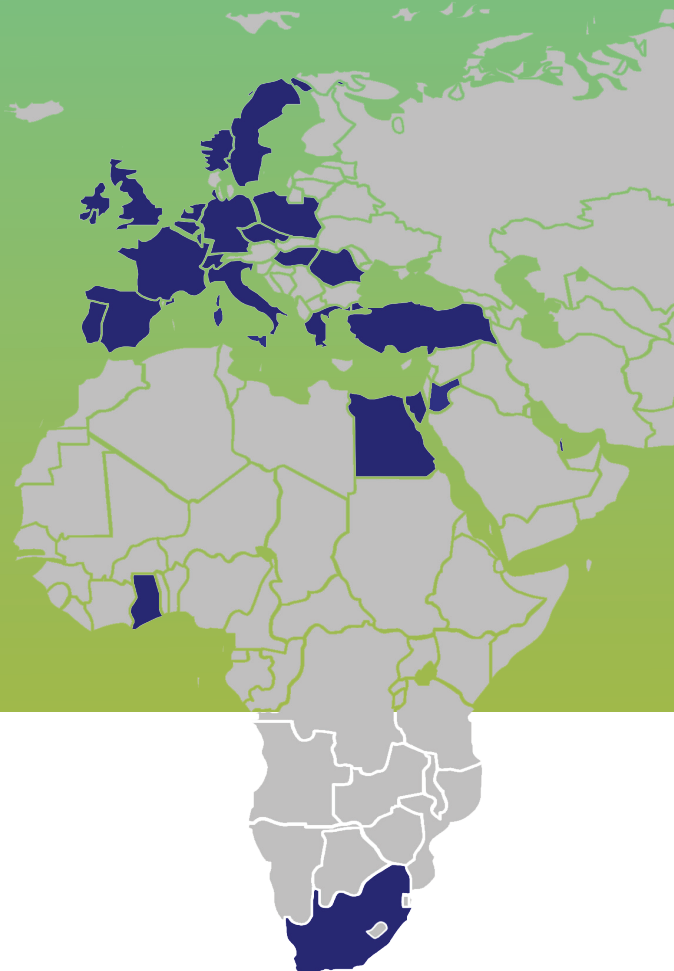
Various Global Biking Initiative events take place during the year organized either locally, in a specific country, or across several countries. They typically last a few days and follow different challenging routes.

Traditionally, the largest event in a year is the GBI Europe, which will take us in 2016 from Vienna to Berlin.

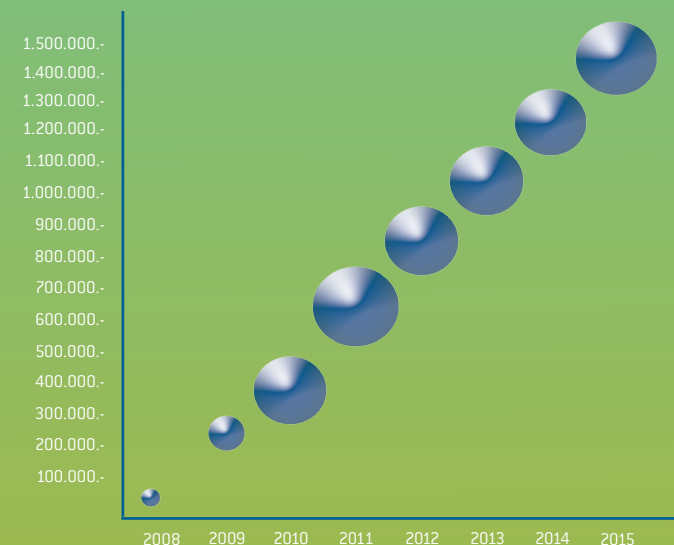
FOR CHARITY
